Most programs of the institution went fully online during the pandemic year 2020-21. All college activities conducted online. To accomplish this, we created a fully integrated online system, in co-ordination with IQAC department and computer and technical support services. Several new initiatives were taken up during this historic year for digital transformation in teaching and learning.

Due to the outbreak of corona -19 Pandemic, direct classes could not be started. The classes of all subjects were regularly taken through the Teachmint app according to the schedule. To complete course outcome Online Exam was conducted by the college. All faculties managed consistency while conducting the online classes and maintained excellent result.
